


A Journey Through Holy Week

PRAY FOR EVERYONE TO HAVE SCRIPTURE IN OUR LIFETIME

Today, we remember Jesus' sermon on the Mount of Olives, in which he proclaimed the importance of the gospel being preached throughout the whole world. And one day, after Matthew 24:14 is completed, we'll get to see the beauty of Revelation 7:9 come to pass:

After this I saw a vast crowd, too great to count, from every nation and tribe and people and language, standing in front of the throne and before the Lamb ...

PRAISE

Out of around 7,395 known languages, 3,436 have Bible translation in progress and 3,621 have at least some Scripture!*

PRAY

Around 1,545 languages have no Scripture. Pray for the day to come quickly when the millions of people who speak these languages can hear and receive the gospel!*

Wednesday

Then Satan entered into Judas Iscariot, who was one of the twelve disciples, and he went to the leading priests and captains of the Temple guard to discuss the best way to betray Jesus to them.

WHEN GOD'S PEOPLE ARE BETRAYED

Today, believers around the world remember an extreme high and an extreme low in Christ's earthly life: being anointed at the home of Simon the Leper and being betrayed by Judas. Jesus knows what it's like to be both loved and forsaken by those in his inner circle.

In an area of Africa where most people follow another major world religion, one Bible translation team has encountered multiple people who have pretended to follow Jesus so they could get close enough to sabotage their work. This is especially painful in a region where translators desperately need more true brothers and sisters encouraging them.

Sadly, this situation is not unique. Many people groups waiting to begin translation live in these types of hostile religious environments.

Teams need fervent intercession as they navigate these difficult situations.



PRAY FOR BIBLE TRANSLATION TEAMS

- That they will include those God wants to include in the work and discern when to say no. That God's Spirit will reveal true hearts and motives.
- For resilience and perseverance to keep going in the face of betrayal.
- For teams to have the willingness and patience to wait and discern who the Lord has chosen for their project, all while feeling such urgency for their people to have God's Word.
- For team members to have grace and love for themselves when they fail to see someone's true character. Ask that they will still trust in the plans of our Almighty God when the plans of men fail.



Thursday

Then he returned to the disciples and found them asleep. He said to Peter, "Couldn't you watch with me even one hour?"

THE CHURCH IS WAKING UP

Today, many in the global body of Christ still haven't awakened to the need for Bible translation. Like the disciples in Gethsemane, they are unaware of the important work God is doing in this hour.

But that's changing! Around the world, Jesus is stirring his bride to intercede and advocate for those still waiting to learn of his love for them.

IN EUROPE

At the recent <u>Global 2033 gathering in Rome</u>, one leader held up a Bible with blank pages and said with tears, "This is why we are here, to fill these pages with God's love so all people can know Christ." Leaders from Catholic and non-Catholic Christian traditions alike officially adopted <u>Pray for Zero</u> to mobilize the church to pray for the Bibleless. Seed Company's Global Director of Prayer, Solomon Lujan, called this a defining moment in the global prayer movement, as Catholics and Protestants united around the need for everyone to have and know God's Word.



IN AFRICA

The inaugural Pray for Zero Africa Summit in Lagos, Nigeria, was marked by unified prayer in multiple languages for every nation and people group awaiting God's Word. Christian leaders from 25 nations caught the vision for bringing the number of languages without God's Word to Zero. "We experienced a taste of Revelation 7:9," said Kanita Rutley, Seed Company's Manager of Prayer Mobilization.

IN THE PACIFIC

At the Pacific Prayer Summit in Cairns, Australia, ministry leaders met to intercede with fervent cries. on behalf of those still without God's Word in the Pacific region. Ministries included Wycliffe Bible Translators, SIL Pacific, Papua New Guinea Bible Translation Association, Australian and South Pacific Houses of Prayer, Pioneer Bible Translators, YWAM, and Seed Company. "This group is excited and committed to mobilize more intercessors to Pray for ZERO," said Tina Hopkins, Seed Company's Manager of Prayer Partnerships.

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED


Today, as we remember Jesus dying on the cross for our sins, we also remember that Bible translators in many parts of the world face persecution, injustice, and even death every day to bring God's Word to their people. They know the meaning of counting the cost and taking up their crosses.

Civil unrest and armed conflict in one Asian country make it dangerous for the Weida* team to check translations among the people for clarity—an essential step for producing accurate, impactful Scripture. If villagers report them to the military or revolutionary forces, they could be arrested or killed. It's been four months since they were able to check any translated Scripture. At times, the translators have fled their homes for safety.

PRAY

That God will give translators wisdom to keep their work low key and protect them from spying eyes.


TODAY, WE REMEMBER THOSE FOR WHOM THE WORD IS STILL SILENT.

THE WORD IS ALIVE!

Today, we rejoice that Jesus, the Word made flesh, is ALIVE. And we praise God for ministry partners like <u>the Jesus Film Project</u> who bring his truth to life for people for the very first time—people like the Bituma* of East Africa.

Many Bituma people follow another major world religion, but after seeing the "JESUS" film, they've asked local team members to return and help start Bible studies and church services. Pray that those who saw the film will receive Christ as Savior!

DID YOU KNOW?

The "JESUS" film has been translated into more than 2,000 languages and has helped lead more than 490 million people to Christ.
