Some parts of South Asia have had Christian presence from the earliest centuries. The region is also the birthplace of major religions Hinduism, Buddhism, and Sikhism. Islam came to the region early in its growth.

Recently, persecution has increased sharply. Bible translation teams are often monitored and scrutinized, and church leaders have been arrested.

Regional Praise Bramar* People of South Asia Receive New Testament

The Bramar New Testament dedication on May 27 honored nearly 10 years of faithful work by translators and those who supported them. About 100 people, mostly Bramar believers, gathered to celebrate. Lead translator Ulasing* delivered an inspiring message based on <u>2 Timothy 3:16</u>, and a group of Bramar youth sang a beloved praise song that had been translated into their language.

Bramar believers, spanning different age groups, genders, and roles within the community, were individually presented with copies of the New Testament—sending the message that the New Testament is meant for all Bramar people. This momentous achievement will bless the Bramar community for generations to come, empowering them with God's life-transforming Word in their heart language.

PRAY FOR A BIBLELESS PEOPLE GROUP Bamboo Terraces Cluster Project

The Bamboo Terraces Cluster Project includes two languages that are classified as first scripture or Bibleless: Honkei (population 7000) and Norbach (population 1500). These two communities are located in remote regions of the project country. Our partner, IEM, has requested help with these two languages.

The Honkei language is part of a larger family of languages located in a neighboring country. A few of these related languages have the New Testament which are not understandable by the Honkei community. The Norbach language is also a subgroup of a larger language community. The Norbach people also struggle to understand any of the scriptures available to them in one of these related languages. Due to their remote locations, both language communities are not able to use the scriptures available to them in the national language.

- Both language teams will begin translation starting with Luke, then Acts, and the 5Ts: 1 & 2 Thessalonians, 1 & 2 Timothy, and Titus.
- The approval process for this cluster project will move smoothly towards a mid-August, 2023, start date.



For a Seed Company translation consultant who is currently in an Asian country helping two teams check the first half of Acts. Pray for all questions to be resolved so that this trip will result in a translation that's clear, natural, and accurate.

PRAY FOR PARTNERS ABC* Theological Seminary in South Asia

Praise God that ABC has sent 60 graduates into Bible translation ministry over the years, including two professors who are now serving as translation consultants after completing <u>Seed Company internships</u>. They're willing to risk opposition and persecution as they travel to help translation teams check Scripture, saying, "It is a step of faith."

ABC also manages a Bible translation project in the Duko* language. Recently, three Duko translators' children completed Bible college programs, and all three returned to serve in youth ministry!

ABC was recently investigated for hosting a western missionary, and more and more churches and Christian workers are experiencing threats and physical attacks. Pray that ABC will continue to flourish despite growing opposition in the country.

PRAY FOR AN ACTIVE TRANSLATION PROJECT Celebrating Five Full New Testaments in South Asia

Five translation teams in South Asia have worked closely with each other over the last decade. Now they will have the joy of crossing the finish line together. More than 320,000 people who speak these languages can already access individual books of the Bible in print, audio, and on an app, but each community is eagerly awaiting the publication of the full New Testament—prayerfully this September.

EQUIPPING THE SAINTS Pray for Litty*, a Sign Language Translation Advisor in South Asia

Litty* sensed a call to serve the Deaf community after she completed a course in sign language at a premier secular institute. She joined <u>DOOR</u> <u>International</u>'s team as a Bible translation advisor trainee, and Seed Company offered her an <u>internship</u>.

At DOOR, translation advisors like Litty are being trained to help teams wrestle through important translation decisions for their language communities. For example, Litty discovered that the phrase "After he has suffered, he will see the light of life" in <u>Isaiah 53:11</u> didn't make much sense in sign language. But the rendering "After a life of suffering, he will again have joy" from the Good News Translation helped the translators understand! Insights like these help produce a translation that will truly speak to the hearts of Deaf people in South Asia.

God is strengthening bonds of love between the Deaf and hearing staff at DOOR International, helping them learn from each other and grow as different members of the body of Christ.

Tens of thousands of people are living in refugee camps. A large percentage of Manipur's population is Christian, including some translators' families.

IMPACT STORY The Journey of Himnauri* Translator Charles*

When Charles heard the gospel in 2006 through a radio program, he was hungry to know more. Later, he was given a Hindi Bible, which led him to follow Christ! When he learned that Bible translation was beginning in Himnauri, his own language, he eagerly joined the team. The journey ahead would not be a smooth one. At one point, he left the project due pressure from his family, but thankfully rejoined in 2020.

Recently, a 14-year-old girl told him, "God has given you the privilege of translating his Word into your language, and many will be blessed through it. And the Holy Spirit will use your translated materials to transform people!" This encouraged him to persevere despite spiritual opposition, knowing his work will impact eternity.
