Praise God for leading the translation team throughout the year to enforce the victory Christ has won on the cross. Pray that the team may continue to be used by the Lord as his chosen representatives, called and authorized to administer the blessing of the New Covenant. — from the Kubokota team in the Solomon Islands

Praise God for enabling us to begin the new phase of Old Testament translation. Pray that the distributed Scriptures, audio Bible, and Bible apps will bring great transformation in the community.

Scripture Publishing Center Up and Running in Cameroon

Printing Scripture is a highly specialized task that's only handled by a few services worldwide. Since the pandemic, manuscripts have been piling up at the printers, causing a long delay between finalizing translated Scripture and actually getting it into people's hands.

That our Cameroon partner organization CABTAL, which works in 116 languages, has opened its own publishing center to print translated Scripture from Cameroon and the surrounding region!

That CABTAL will encounter no obstacles to this huge increase in their printing capacity.

PRAY FOR A BIBLELESS PEOPLE GROUP Mambema in Cameroon

Most of the 40,000 Mambema speakers are Christians, but not having the Bible in their own language has prevented many from fully understanding the gospel. Before, it was thought that Mambema was a dialect of another language called Medumba, but they've confirmed that they cannot readily understand the Medumba Bible.

PRAISE

- For Mambema speakers who have been faithfully praying for Bible translation to begin and have raised \$5,000 locally to lay the foundation for a potential future project.
- For local volunteers who have been laying the linguistic groundwork in preparation for translation.

PRAY

- For unity among the Mambema communities and church leaders who are scattered across a wide area.
- For the remaining linguistic work that needs to be done before Bible translation can hopefully begin.

PRAY FOR PARTNERS Bagirmi Bible Translation Association in Chad

Most of the 100,000 Bagirmi (BAH – GEER – MEE) people in Chad follow Islam, but there is a small group of ~10 local believers. Bagirmi translators have translated some oral Bible stories, and now they hope to build a firm foundation for the first Bagirmi church through translating Luke, Acts, and 1–2 Samuel.

However, these translators have had trouble getting off the ground. They've formed their own Bible translation association (ABT for short), but they haven't been able to open a bank account to support it. Thus far, the official has been unwilling to endorse their paperwork.

PRAY

- For favor with this government official so ABT can get the approval they need.
- For individual believers to be strengthened in their faith and equipped to tell Bible stories.



Pray Now

For an interdenominational group of 49 church leaders in a sensitive region of the Sahel as they proceed with a Church-Based Bible Translation project, led by another translation organization. Translators have ambitious goals of engaging every language on this region's list of remaining needs! Seed Company has been asked to give input on how to ensure quality translation. Pray for good collaboration and wisdom in this hard-to-access, dangerous area.



Wednesday

May all Toussian Nord speakers seek the Kingdom of God above all else and discover that he alone provides everything they need!
