Interns in Southern Africa Learn How to Engage Communities with God's Word

A group of 9 interns in Southern Africa are in a 3-year training program that's equipping them with technology and media skills to ensure that Bible translation really does end in life transformation.

They're learning:

- Information technology
- Language technology
- Digital content creation
- Media distribution tools like <u>Walking with Jesus</u> series and <u>The</u> <u>Covenant movie</u>
- Gospel conversation techniques

PRAY FOR AN ACTIVE TRANSLATION PROJECT Songo in Angola

The Songo community received the complete New Testament in their language just a few years ago, and they're making great progress on the Old Testament. While most Songo people profess Christianity, church leaders hope Scripture in their own language will help release people from strongholds of polygamy, witchcraft, and drug addiction. May all Songo people trust the one true Creator and Healer as they receive his Word!



TESTIMONY & PRAYER REQUESTS FROM THE SONGO TEAM

Pastor Esmael, a translator and project coordinator, shares:

"I became a Bible translator because of the need to have the Word of God in my own language. My people need the Bible to fulfill Jesus' call to go and proclaim the Good News to the ends of the earth.

"The dream I have is to get the complete Bible and for the new generation to be able to continue the work until we have a study Bible in Songo and many other books teaching the Word."

IMPACT STORY Southern African Sign Languages

More than 1.2 million Deaf people in Lesotho, Zimbabwe, Malawi, Eswatini, Namibia, and Botswana are awaiting God's Word. At a recent Bible training camp with our partner <u>Hands with Words</u>, 105 people from these countries deepened their Deaf engagement and translation skills.

PRAISE

- That many sign language translation projects have already begun, and more workers are getting trained in July!
- That this past January, the first Deaf church was opened in Zimbabwe.
- For the strong partnership between the Deaf community and hearing churches; many hearing believers are learning sign languages.

PRAY

- For the sign language teams in Malawi, Eswatini, Lesotho, and Namibia to secure funding for their projects within the next six months.
- For Hands with Words as they provide support, encouragement, and direction for these newer projects.
- For unity, clarity, and removal of obstacles for sign language staff in Eswatini.
