REGIONAL UPDATE Bible Complete in Lik [LEEK] Language of Islands Asia

We've prayed the Lik Bible to the finish line throughout the last 2 years as the team progressed through the final <u>typesetting</u> and <u>printing</u> stages. Now, the 7,000 people who speak this language get to hold the Bible in their hands!

PRAISE

- Acceleration: Because the Lik Bible was adapted from a related language (Ketning), the entire process took only 14 years. That's 26 years quicker than the language it was adapted from, giving a *whole extra generation* access to God's Word in the language of their hearts!
- **Multiplication**: One Lik translator has become the translation advisor for another team working in a nearby language, helping them produce better work than ever.
- **Transformation & Celebration**: After the full Bible dedication, 42 people presented themselves for baptism. The next day, the community held a huge feast: 70 pigs slow-cooked in shallow pits lined with heated rocks!

PRAY FOR BIBLELESS PEOPLE GROUPS IN KALIMANTAN, INDONESIA

And then he told them, "Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone." — Mark 16:15 (NLT)

When Christianity was first introduced in the early 1900s in this region of Indonesia, many began to follow Jesus. Today, about half of the Kanang, Kompang, and Jalinken people consider themselves Christians. But without God's Word in their heart language, many still practice spirit worship.

PRAISE

- That these 3 people groups along with 2 others will receive the book of Luke and Acts by 2026!
- That recently translated Scripture is <u>already making an impact</u>.

PRAY

- For translated Scripture to help local teachers in their effectiveness.
- That Scripture would bring clarity and truth to those who still practice ethnic religions alongside Christianity.
- For young people to be led to spouses who love Jesus rather than marrying those of other faiths.

TRANSLATED SCRIPTURE: SARB LANGUAGE IN THE PHILIPPINES

"Don't be dejected and sad, for the joy of the Lord is your strength!" — Nehemiah 8:10b (NLT)

"Na nang gamu flidù du i klehew gablé Dwata én gafbagal gamu."

— Nihimaya 8:10b (Sarb)

"And do not be worried because the joy that God gives that is what will make you strong." — Nehemiah 8:10b (translated back into English from Sarb)

PRAY FOR AN ACTIVE TRANSLATION PROJECT South Sea Cluster in the Philippines

The South Seas Cluster includes two languages, Sarb and Korb, which are spoken collectively by more than 250,000 people. They are working on Nehemiah and other Old Testament books and looking forward to the day when the full Bible is available in both of these languages.

PRAY

- For the local translators to have a good understanding of the Word and strength, wisdom, and perseverance for translating it.
- For our partners to have all the resources they need, including both finances and people, to fulfill everything God has called them to do.



PRAY FOR AN ACTIVE TRANSLATION PROJECT Robeno [ROH – BEH' – NOH] Cluster of Islands Asia

Most of the 619,000 people who speak the six languages in the Robeno <u>Cluster project</u> claim faith in Christ, yet fear of evil spirits is common. Those who do not take part in rituals and sacrifices are ostracized for bringing shame on their families. Some Christians succumb to outside pressure and leave their faith.

But local church leaders are seeing heart language Scripture make a difference. As more people comprehend the meaning of Christ's sacrifice, their faith is strengthened.

PRAISE

That the six translation teams of the Robeno Cluster are translating God's Word for more than half a million people. They're not only translating the second half of the New Testament but also providing training for future translation advisors and consultants.

PRAY

For many lives to be transformed by the translated Scripture that's already circulating among the communities.

Fifteen key women leaders serving in six translation organizations recently gathered for a retreat in beautiful Bogor, Indonesia. They covered important topics regarding ministry, family, friendship, and leadership, and connected over their unique responsibilities and callings in these areas.

PRAY

For God to bring great fruit from this retreat in these women's lives. May they blossom like well-watered gardens, radiant in their splendor and continually bearing fruit for the Kingdom.

Partners Work Together to Begin Translation in Several Languages

PRAISE

That the <u>Ripple Effect</u> continues to gain momentum in Islands Asia. Translation programs are beginning in several languages, the fruit of unity between churches and Bible translation groups. Church leaders and community engagement coordinators have been presenting projects to directors of translation organizations. They are committed to working together to reach the Bibleless.



Praise God

That after struggling for more than two decades, the Eswe team in Islands Asia is seeing increased acceptance and usage of Eswe Scripture by local churches. This project is part of a broader effort to reach the 400,000 Eswe people, 99% of whom follow another major world religion. House fellowships are using translated Scripture in their weekly meetings, fostering a movement of Eswe people following Jesus! Please pray for the partnership between the translation team and churches to continue to grow and flourish.

IMPACT STORY A Story of Reconciliation and Love: Embracing the Lessons of 2 Samuel in the Philippines
